10.04.010 Limit of One Hundred Twenty Hours. It shall be unlawful for any person who owns, has possession, custody, or control of any vehicle to park such vehicle upon any street or alley within the town for more than a consecutive period of one hundred twenty (120) hours.

10.04.020 Removal of Vehicles. In the event a vehicle is parked in violation of any regulations of the town, such vehicle may be removed from the place so parked by any member of the police department.

The vehicle so removed shall be taken to the nearest garage or other place of safety or to a garage designated or maintained by the town and the cost of removal and storage shall be paid by the owner or operator of the vehicle so removed.

10.04.030 Removal of Vehicles During Street Cleaning. The owner or person responsible for a motor vehicle or trailer shall, upon request of any police officer representing the town, or a representative of the town road maintenance department, remove his motor vehicle or trailer from any street or alley within the town when necessary for the cleaning and maintenance of the street or alley or for snow removals.

10.04.040 Violation; Penalty. Any person found willfully violating any provision of section 10.04.030 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine of ten dollars (\$10.00) for a first conviction; twenty dollars (\$20.00) for a second conviction, and an additional ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be added to the fine for each conviction thereafter; provided, however, that the judge may in his discretion suspend or defer imposition of a fine in whole or in part.

## 10.04.050 Regulation of Parking on Other Streets.

- (1) It shall be unlawful for any motor or other vehicle to park at any time other than parallel to the street and adjacent to the curbs, walkways or sidewalks thereto.
- (2) Diagonal parking shall be allowed on the north side of Highway 10 (Mullan Road), but limited to the East and West 100 blocks; and shall be allowed on either side of Arizona Avenue; and shall be allowed at Timberman Park; and shall be allowed for one hundred fifty (150) feet east of the swimming pool on the south side of 5th Avenue East; and shall be allowed on the South side of Riverside Avenue East between River Street and Cedar Street; and shall be allowed on the South side of 5th Avenue East between Arizona Avenue and Pennsylvania Avenue; and shall be allowed on the either side of Pennsylvania Avenue between 4th Avenue East and 6th Avenue East.
- (3) It shall be unlawful to park within twenty (20) feet of any fire hydrant.
- (4) It shall be unlawful for any motor or other vehicle to park at any time within twenty (20) feet of crosswalks or street intersections.
- (5) No U turns shall be permitted on River Street between the south end of the bridge and 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue; and including the intersection of 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and River Street.

<u>10.4.070 Penalties.</u> Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable as provided in Section 1.08.010 of the Town Code.
