## GENERAL OFFENSES

9.02.010 Use of Dangerous Instrumentalities. It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully use or allow the use of dangerous instrumentalities, including, but not limited to, bows and arrows, slingshots, crossbows, or other similar instruments within the town limits.

9.02.020 False Fire Alarms. It shall be unlawful for any person, willfully, or designedly, to give, assist in giving, countenance, or request or cause to be given, any false alarm of fire in any manner within the town limits. This section shall not apply to members of the fire department in making tests or repairs under the direction of proper authorities.

9.02.030 Destruction of Fire Alarm Equipment. It shall be unlawful for any person to tamper, meddle, or in any way, interfere with any station or signal device, or willfully to break, injure, deface, or remove, or to make any connection or communication with the poles, wires, boxes, or devices of the fire alarm system of the town so as to interrupt or interfere with the proper working of the same, or to mutilate, injure, or destroy any notices that may be legally posted relating to the same.

9.02.040 Interference with Firemen. It shall be unlawful for any person, at the burning of a building, to disobey the lawful order of any public officer or fireman, or to offer any resistance to, or interference with, the lawful efforts of any fireman or company of firemen to extinguish the same, or to engage in any disorderly conduct calculated to prevent the same from being extinguished, or to forbid, prevent, or dissuade other from assisting the same, or to run over hose, or molest firemen while fighting a fire, or to park a car within fifty (50) yards of the fire truck while at a fire.

9.02.050 Violations; Penalty. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable as provided in Section 1.08.010 of this Code.
