2.06.010 Mayor to be Chief Executive Officer. The Mayor shall be the chief executive officer of the Town.

2.06.020 Qualifications. Qualifications for the office of Mayor shall be as provided by the Charter for the Town of Superior.

2.06.030 Powers. In addition to the powers of the Mayor as provided by the Charter for the Town of Superior, the Mayor shall have the power to veto any objectionable part of a resolution or ordinance, and approve other parts; the said veto shall be subject to override by four (4) affirmative council votes.

2.06.040 Mayor to Act as President of Council. He shall be present at the meetings of the council and shall act as the president thereof, and when there is a tie upon any question before the council he shall give the casting vote; he shall have the power to veto any resolution or ordinance or any part thereof; he shall sign all warrants on the town treasury and all permits or permissions granted by the council, and all contracts made by and on behalf of the town with any other party.

2.06.050 In the Absence of the Mayor. In the absence of the Mayor from the town or from his inability from any cause to discharge the duties of his office, the president of the council shall exercise all the powers and discharge all the duties of the Mayor. In case of absence or inability of the Mayor and president of the council, the council may appoint one of its number to act in his place. The president or member of the council while performing the duties of the mayor shall be styled the acting mayor. Any acting mayor performing the duties of the mayor shall be entitled to the salary of the mayor.

2.06.060 Mayor to Appoint Officers. He shall at the first meeting of the council after the election each year, and from time to time thereafter, appoint, subject to confirmation of the council, all necessary officers of the town and he shall in like manner appoint any other officers whose offices are created by ordinance.
