

CHAPTER 4.09

GREASE AND SAND TRAPS REQUIRED

Section 4.09.010 Requiring grease and sand traps. No person operating a service station, garage or similar place having wash or grease racks shall discharge the waste water to the Town of Superior sewer system unless such place is provided with a sand and grease trap. No person operating a restaurant or food preparation establishment discharging waste water to the Town of Superior sewer system containing greater than one hundred (100)mg/1 of oil and grease or that has a recurring problem with grease buildup or blockage of sewer lines shall fail to install an adequate grease trap.

Section 4.09.020 Type, capacity, and maintenance of grease and sand traps. All sand and grease traps shall be of a type and capacity approved by the Town of Superior sewer Superintendent, and shall be located so as to be readily and easily accessible for cleaning and inspection. In the maintaining of these sand and grease traps the owner(s) shall be responsible for the proper removal and disposal by appropriate means of the captured material and shall maintain records of the dates, and means of disposal which are subject to review by the Town of Superior sewer Superintendent. Any removal and hauling of the collected materials not performed by owner(s) personnel must be performed by currently licensed waste disposal firms.

Section 4.09.030 Violations and penalties. Any person found violating any provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty and no/100(50.00) Dollars and not to exceed Five hundred and no/100(500.00).
